The number of birds that lose their lives by flying into windows is staggering. According to the Fatal Light Awareness Program (FLAP), approximately 1 billion birds die every year in North America alone due to window collisions.

You can help! Join NDN's GBR team from Oct. 5th to 11th. Team members will document bird collisions with windows in their homes, cottages or even places of work by checking the outside of their windows daily during the week for possible bird collisions. Team members will then enter their data into the Global bird collision mapper. This vital information "will help incentivize new policies and laws designed to reduce bird-building collisions worldwide." (FLAP Global Bird Rescue manual)
